Law Student Colloquium 2010

The second annual **Law Student Colloquium** will take place in the Law School, Trinity College Dublin, on Saturday, 20 February 2010. This conference will be chaired by Mrs Justice Catherine McGuinness, President of the Law Reform Commission, and brings together law students to present and discuss their work under the general theme of "Rethinking Law." Law students, both undergraduate and postgraduate, and researchers from all institutions, are invited to attend and participate.

The **Colloquium** will consist of several panels, with individual presentations (10-15 minutes each) on related topics followed by general discussion. Each panel will be chaired by an expert in the relevant area of law. We welcome applications to present papers from postgraduates and undergraduates. The **Colloquium** provides an excellent opportunity to explore current and future developments in the law, to obtain feedback on your ideas and to experience presenting and participating at a law conference. There will be prizes for the best undergraduate papers.
